

CITY COUNCIL INSTITUTES NEW PROCEDURE REGARDING CONTINUED ITEMS

With a number of items continued or tabled at City Council meetings, the North Las Vegas City Council is taking a step to eliminate as much inconvenience as possible to citizens who attend Council meetings with an interest in one or more particular agenda items. Beginning with the meeting of April 21, 2004, requests for continuances received in the City Clerk's Office by 11:45 a.m. on the day of the meeting will be posted on the City's web site no later than 3:00 p.m. that day. Requests received after 11:45 a.m. will be posted on a bulletin board in Council Chambers, along with the requests which were previously received.

A request for continuance does not guarantee an item will be postponed, but gives notice to involved and interested parties that this is a possibility. Persons with an interest in items on the agenda should check the web site after 3:00 p.m. on meeting day to ascertain which items have the possibility of being continued.

The North Las Vegas City Council meets the first and third Wednesdays of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall at 2200 Civic Center Drive, North Las Vegas. Public Hearings begin at 6:15 p.m. For further information, contact the City Clerk's Office at 633-1030.
