



City of North Las Vegas Committees and Advisory Boards

Be part of the Progress!

The City is looking for North Las Vegas residents to volunteer to serve on various boards, committees and commissions. If you are interested in helping shape the future of our City, we invite you to consider serving on one of these pivotal boards. Complete the form and send or fax it to the City Clerk's Office. When an opening occurs, the City Council will review all applications and an appointment will be made at a regularly scheduled City Council meeting. Individuals appointed will be notified by the City Clerk's office.

1. Citizens Advisory Committee: Makes recommendations for allocating Community Development Block Grant funds to meet the needs of low to moderate income groups through decent housing, developing viable communities and neighborhoods and promoting economic growth. Meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the City Manager's Conference Room at City Hall, or as needed.

2. North Las Vegas Library District Board of Trustees - the governing/policy making authority for the North Las Vegas Library District. Regular meetings are held bimonthly on the fourth Tuesday of January, March, May, July, September, and November at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.

3. Parks and Recreation Advisory Board - provides input on recreation programs, parks maintenance issues, recreational facility locations and the need for new facilities. Regular meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month at 5:45 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.

4. Americans with Disabilities Advisory Board - discusses issues of ADA compliance for City property and employees and meets every second Tuesday at 3:30 p.m. in the Human Resources Conference Room, or as needed.

5. Civil Service Board of Trustees - Adjudicating board for City employee complaints. Meets the third Tuesday in January, April, July and October at 5:00 p.m. in City Council Chambers, or as needed.

6. Joint Board of Appeals - consists of members who are qualified by experience and training and are not City employees to review matters pertaining to building construction. The Board hears and decides appeals of orders, decisions or determinations made by the building official relative to applications and interpretations of codes. Meets the third Tuesday of each quarter at 3:30 p.m., in the Community Development Center Building Safety Conference Room, or as needed.

7. Planning Commission - makes recommendations to the City Council on matters of planning and zoning; reviews and approves tentative maps, special use permits, variances, etc. Regular meetings are held the second and fourth Wednesday at 6:00 p.m. in City Council Chambers.

8. Redevelopment Advisory Committee - studies, reviews, advises and makes recommendations to the Redevelopment Agency on policy matters concerning the designated redevelopment areas and neighborhood revitalization as requested by the Agency. Meetings are held the 2nd Tuesday of each quarter in the Economic Development Conference Room at 6:00 p.m. or as needed.

9. Traffic and Parking Committee - reviews matters concerning traffic safety on City streets to promote the livability of neighborhoods and to facilitate efficiency in the transportation network to facilitate a more vibrant business environment. Develops and recommends traffic safety related policies to City Council. Regular meetings are held on the second Monday of February, May, August and November at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.

10. Senior Advisory Board - Not yet established.

11. Utilities Advisory Board - reviews matters relevant to water and wastewater utilities. Meets semi-annually on 1st Tuesday of April and October.

12. County, Regional and State Boards - various boards and committees in which the City of North Las Vegas participates, including but not limited to: Clark County Community Development Advisory Committee, Clark County Nuclear Waste Division Steering Committee, and Regional Flood Control District Citizens Advisory Committee.

The following committees are formed on an as-needed basis:

13. Mayor's Task Forces - various recommending bodies formed at the request of the Mayor. Appointments are made by the Mayor.

14. Ballot Question Advisory Committee - in the event of a ballot question, committees will be formed to develop arguments for and against passage. Note: This is an ad hoc, temporary committee that will be formed only in the event of a ballot question.
