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# 4. <u>DIRECTION TO STAFF AND SELECTION OF GATEWAY MONUMENT DESIGNS</u> FOR ENTRYWAYS OF THE CITY OF NORTH LAS VEGAS BY ED BRONDO, SENIOR LANDSCAPE DESIGNER, WRG DESIGN, INC (EXHIBIT A).

Acting Community Development Director Kenny Young introduced Ed Brondo, Senior Landscape Designer, WRG Design, Inc., who presented suggested monument designs for the entry corridors. Mr. Brondo reviewed the options and prices for three monument designs. All were made from formed concrete with a stone veneer and were illuminated at night. They ranged from eight to15 feet tall and contained the City's logo either in bronze or layered and painted. Mr. Brondo introduced Ethel Scott who described the materials used in the design of the signs. Board Member Montandon asked about the durability of the materials if someone tried to vandalize them and Ms. Scott replied most of the material was a form of cement and could be sand-blasted. Board Member Smith complimented the designers for bringing good options to the Board and stated she was in favor of the taller sign. Mr. Brondo suggested using the tallest design for the dominant boulevards and one or both of the other designs at smaller intersections. He stated the taller sign would range from \$40,000 to \$46,000, the smaller monument sign from \$23,000 to \$29,000 and the monument with the triangle from \$14,000 to \$20.000, all without the bronze. Once the mold was made, the more signs the Council purchased, the less expensive they were.
